Education Question and Answer

The OHJA Education Committee will include an education question in each monthly OHJA newsletter. The first ten (10) correct answers received from members will be recorded each month, and the member with the most correct answers will be announced and receive a gift at the 2006 awards banquet. Answers should be mailed or emailed to Trish Helmer. The correct answer to each month's question will be published in the following month's newsletter.

October Question: (a) Name five parts of the foot visible on the underside of an unshod hoof. (b) From where does the wall of the hoof grow?

September Question: What is a horse's normal body temperature, pulse and respiration rate when at rest?

Answer: When at rest, a horse's normal body temperature is 100.5, its pulse is 36-42 beats per minute, and it should inhale 8 to 12 times per minute.
